Shanghai is the largest city in China and is China's leading business hub. Shanghai's GDP accounts are approximately 25 percent of China's total GDP. The **Jiangsu** province recently signed an MOU with California for cooperative renewable energy projects. **Changsha, Hunan** is one of China's most industrious 2nd tier marketplaces.

CleanTech Industry Booms in China

- China is the world leading renewable energy producer.
- In 2005, a total of US\$38 billion was invested in renewable energy development worldwide. China topped the list with a commitment of US\$6 billion.
- China has declared a 20% reduction in greenhouse gases by 2020.
- The U.S. and China government plans to develop a U.S.-China Clean Energy Research Center. The Center would facilitate joint research and development on clean energy by teams of scientists and engineers from U.S. and China, as well as acting as a clearinghouse to help researchers in each country.
- Shanghai, China has developed eco-friendly and energy-friendly industrial zones with city projects, such as, Dongtan, which will be China's first ecologically friendly, zero-greenhouse-emission city completely self-sufficient in water and energy.

One-on-one meetings will also occur with the 2nd tier marketplace of Changsha, Hunan, a bustling metropolis of 4,000,000 people who need air and water purification, green construction, renewable energy and waste management technologies.
