OCT 23, 2010 (SAT) DEPART FROM WEST COAST (-/-/-)

Depart from SFO/LAX to Shanghai on jumbo jet. Please arrive airport 3 hours prior to departure.

OCT 24, 2010 (SUN) ARR. SHANGHAI (-/-/-)

Welcome to Shanghai, the largest city in China. On arrival, meet Asia Getaway bi-lingual staff and transfer to hotel. After check-in at the hotel, relax and recover from the jetlag.

Transfer to Jiangsu, which recently signed an MOU with California for cooperative renewable energy and green projects. It is one of the wealthiest regions in China. It also has a partnership with MBITA.

OCT 29, 2010 (FRI) SHANGHAI (B/D)

Full day explore the **World Expo 2010** sites; World Expo is a culturally and artistically rich event that offers youth from around the world an opportunity to experience the core values focus - "Understanding, Communication, Gathering and Cooperation". The 2010 theme is Better Living, Better City. Special visit to the U S Pavilion.

Farewell dinner with de-briefing. All delegates can share the business experience and plan for their China strategy.
