Mr. O'Connor serves as the Director of Ex-Im Bank's Office of Renewable Energy & Environmental Exports.

Mr. O'Connor was appointed as the Bank's Environmental Liaison Officer in 1994, to implement the Bank's top-priority mission to increase its support for environmentally beneficial exports. Mr. O'Connor created and managed the Bank's Environmental Exports Program, which grew from 13 transactions in fiscal year 1994 to 71 transactions in 2007, with a total portfolio in excess of \$2 billion.

Mr. O'Connor was appointed as the Director of Ex-Im Bank's Office of Renewable Energy & Environmental Exports in 2008.

Mr. O'Connor began his career at the Bank as a Loan Officer in the Export Credit Insurance Division covering the Middle East and North Africa.

Mr. O'Connor has represented the Bank on over 50 international missions that included China, India, Brazil, Mexico, and Turkey, as well as other major markets in the ASEAN region, Latin America, Eastern Europe, and the Middle East.

In addition to his position at the Bank, Mr. O'Connor has served as an *Adjunct Professor* of International Business at Georgetown University since the Spring Semester of 1997. In May 2003, he was presented with Georgetown University's *Adjunct Faculty of the Year* award for his outstanding teaching.

Mr. O'Connor's professional experience also includes experience in the U.S. capital markets with the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation, and in the insurance industry with the Chubb Group.
